NOVELS



NATIONAL NOVEL WRITING MONTH

National Novel Writing Month (often shortened NaNoWriMo) is a U.S.-based nonprofit organization that promotes creative writing around the world. Its flagship is annual. program an international creative writing event in which participants attempt to write a 50,000word manuscript during the month of November. Wellknown authors write "peptalks" in order to motivate participants during the month. website The provides participants, called "Wrimos", with tips for writer's block, information on where local participants are meeting, and an online community support. Focusing on length of a work rather than quality, writers encouraged to finish their first draft quickly so it can be edited later at their discretion. The project started in July 1999 with 21 participants. In 2019, 455,080 participated in the organization's programs.










TRENDING BOOKS TODAY


